December 7, 2018 – SCABWG (South Central Arizona Border Wildfire Group) meeting. Mostly talked about California fires and problems with communications, truck checks and timecards. Arivaca and Sonoita expressed concerns about abundance of grass in district boundaries. Elephant Head reported on truck accident in Nevada and how the injured firefighters are still recovering. Agreed to keep the 48 hour for initial attack on wildland fires. Also talked about the SCABWG web page and keeping it updated.
