FROM THE NOVEMBER MEETING TO THIS MEETING:

CON INSPECTION: We had one ambulance inspected. We passed the ALS inspection. The other is still not running.

VEHICLE REPAIRS: We are still working on Rescue 501.

I took the SUV (Chiefs vehicle) up to Johnny Lakes to get fixed.

NEW EMPLOYEES: 3 new EMT's and 1 new firefighter

CLASSES: We currently have heard from 6 people interested in taking the EMR class.

FUELS REDUCTION: We have actively been working on the fuels reduction.

OTHER:

I attended the Local Emergency Planning Committee in Rio Rico. At the meeting the Red Cross Notification process and countrywide classes on Bomb Building Recognition were discussed. Also the SCC Planner update, emergency management update, IEMC report, Border 2020 update and WebEOC update. The working lunch included a propane/Emergency Response manual exercise. The next meeting is January 19th, 2017.

We also received an email from Pima Community College letting us know the Paramedic course was ending so we sent them up a flyer and information to post for us letting them know we were hiring.

The AFD Auxiliary received a check for \$12,000 from the White Elephant Grant to pay off Brush 503. We contacted Ford and the payoff amount is \$12,457.96. That total is good until January 7th. At the Auxiliary meeting last night the board approved donating the full amount of the payoff. So we will be paying off that truck.

We have someone interested in Brush 501 (One of the vehicle that was approved by the board to sell). We listed it on Craig's list. We are waiting for them to put in a bid.

I signed up with the Arizona Fire District Association to take the classes I need on line. I have received all the materials and will start on the classes this coming month.
